

No window facing a public right-of-way shall be changed, removed, enclosed, or covered without a building permit, if applicable, except that damaged windows may be boarded up for a reasonable temporary period, not to exceed 30 days, while repairs are being arranged. Replacement of any window with the same size window does not need a building permit and is not prohibited under this provision. Any building renovations approved under this Code must treat such windows as an integral part of the building facade.
